



CLINICAL PROTOCOL

PASSIVE ALIGNERS

The arches may have different numbers of stages.

ANTERIOR TEETH LEVELING UPPER

Canines and centrals at the same level and laterals 0.5mm above.

EXPANSION

Only permanent teeth are to be expanded.

EXPANSION (PER ARCH)

Expansion between 2mm to 4mm is planned.

CURVE OF SPEE

Ideal/flat curve of spee
(by combination of tipping, intrusion and extrusion).

**TO CORRECT
CLASS II**

Sequential distalization with IPR on the upper arch.

Sequential distalization with IPR on the lower arch.

**OVERJET &
OVERBITE**

Ideal overjet with no anterior contact is set.

IPR

No IPR
on primary teeth.

Start IPR
whenever necessary at any stage.

IPR Maximum
0.4 mm for anteriors
0.5 mm for posteriors

CROWDING**Mild to Moderate**

Canines and premolars are to be expanded, IPR is applied as needed, and anterior protrusion.

Moderate to Severe

Canines and premolar regions are to be expanded, and sequential distalization up to 2mm - 2.5mm, no third molars.

IPR is placed as needed, but no anterior round tripping.
